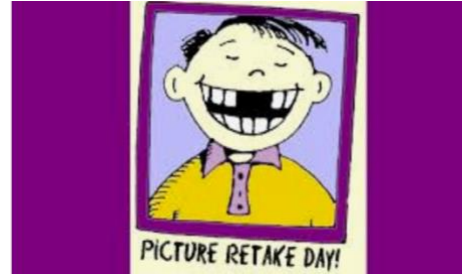
Remembrance Day—Thank you!
