EDUCATION BEGINS AT HOME

Here are some things you can do at home to help your child in school:

HOMEWORK:

Children need a place to do school work.

Set some limits:

- be flexible (some nights more time will be needed than others)
- put aside a block of time for doing homework or home study
- discourage phone calls/texts from friends during this time
- minimize time on the computer unless it is for researching or doing assignments
- provide breaks for a snack

Take an interest in the work your child is doing:

- ask about his or her school work
- provide the necessary tools for completing work (dictionary, pencils, paper...)
- help your child proofread his/her work
- help your child prepare for tests by quizzing them on what has been learned
- encourage neat and accurate work
- encourage your child to take pride in the quality of work submitted for marking

- Review work to see if it is completed and ready for school the next day.
- Encourage your child to take responsibility for completing homework.
- Encourage your child to seek out help at school as needed.
