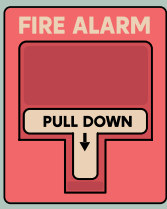

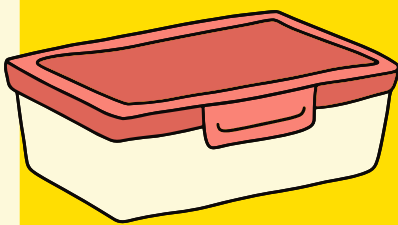

\$1 snacks in the gym.



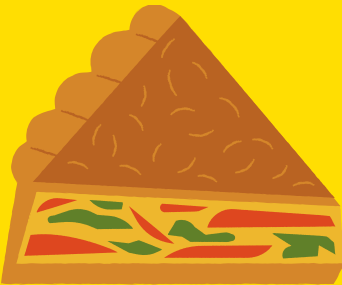
PAC SNACK SALES

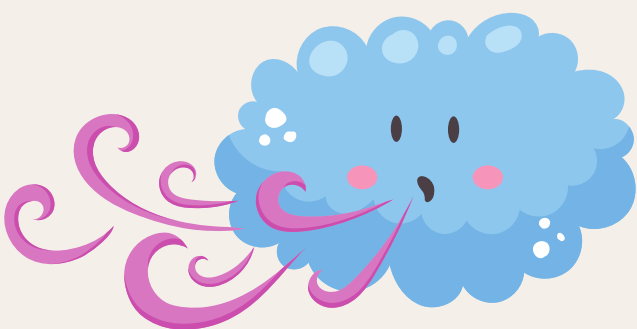
