

PARKING LOT SAFETY REMINDERS




Reminders of where to park and where to stop your car and drop off.

SCHOOL SUPPLIES FES DUE

This is a reminder that Basic School Supplies and Agendas are due by October 15, 2022. Please pay ONLINE by going to blundell.sd38.bc.ca and clicking on SchoolCashOnline located on the right side of the page. Please register with your child's Pupil Number and click on 'Sign In' and follow each step as prompted. Please phone the office, if you need help with the ONLINE program.

For students in Divisions 1-7, agenda is an additional \$6, totalling \$36 per student (\$30 school supplies + \$6 agenda). All students except those in Divisions 8, 9 and 10 will use an agenda for home/school communication purposes. Our school district is able to do a bulk purchase of school supplies, which allow the district to offer supplies for a very reasonable cost.

REMINDER: The provincial government announced a

new, one time Student and Family Affordability Fund. This fund is designed to assist families who require financial assistance with school related costs such as school and course fees, workbooks, specialty supplies, field trips and other school-related charges and costs. The additional funding will also be used to support school meal programs and other nutritional supports for students.
