Thank you to Homma Elementary for the text below.

We are excited to let the community know that we have a snack fridge at Blundell. This fridge was funded through the Ministry of Education Feeding Futures Program. Students are able to access food in the fridge, when they need a nutritious snack to help them get through the day. We know that healthy minds and bodies begin with fresh quality food. The fridge will be stocked with food delivered by the Richmond Food Bank and Fire Fighters. We are grateful for their support!

In the coming weeks, staff will be working with students to understand the purpose for the fridge, as well as the difference between a want and a need. It may be helpful to have a conversation with your child about when to take food and when to leave it. We know that, in the beginning, students will find the fridge a bit of a novelty and may use it more than needed. We are okay with this, but in the weeks ahead, our goal is to have students access the fridge when needed.
