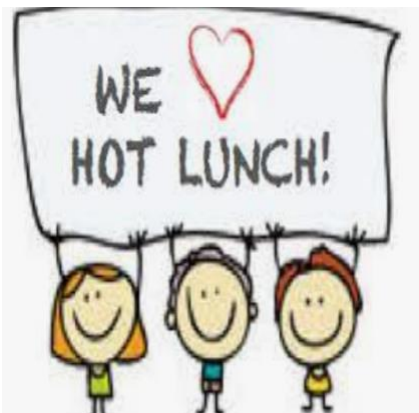

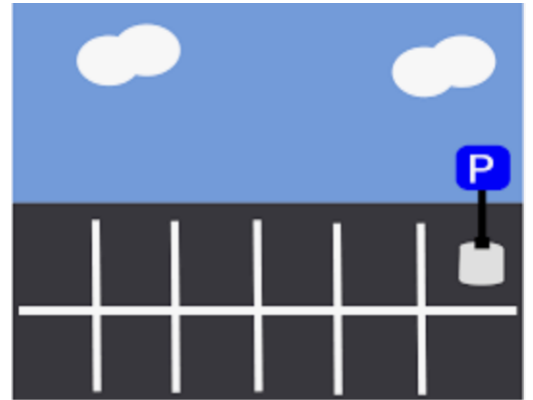


PAC Hot Lunch #2
